Objective

Programme

- Basic atomic theory
- Biological effects of radiation
- Understanding of the sources of natural and artificial radiation
- Understanding of units relating to dose and activity
- Principles of radiological protection
- Role of the RPS and expectations under IRR17

Evaluation

Written examination – 70% of the final grade
Individual interview – 30% of the final grade
